RESTRAINT OF STUDENTS

The Jackson County Board of Education requires that all schools and programs within the school district comply with State Board of Education Rule 290-3-1-.02(1)(f) regarding the use of defined within the rule.

Physical Restraint

This procedure is not intended to prevent the use of physical restraint in limited circumstances where a student is an immediate danger to himself or others and the student is not responsive less intensive behavioral interventions, including verbal directives or other de-

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student handbook.

Seclusion

The Board of Education also prohibits the use of seclusion, as that term is defined in State Board of Education Rule 290-3-1-.02(1) (f).
